inData has released an iPad version of its DepoView software which allows iPad users to review synchronized video depositions and transcripts, make clips and export clips files for presentation. This application is free of charge and is designed to run on iOS 5.1.1 or higher and includes the following features:

- Create and manage multiple case folders
- Access multiple depositions from a single case folder
- Import transcript and video deposition files directly through iTunes®
- Accepts the following import formats from inData Timecoder™ Pro:
 - .XML OpenDVT XML (Transcript only)
 - .DVT DepoView Transcript (Transcript only)
 - .DVI Synchronized video transcript (Video and transcript)
- Multiple navigation options include:
 - Play the entire video transcript testimony from the beginning, tapping the video screen to pause or play
 - Select keywords from the Word Index to jump directly to a specific video position
 - Tap any transcript text to immediately navigate to the associated video position
 - Flip through transcript pages, forward or backward, with the touch of a button
- Colored bar scrolls through the associated transcript text during video playback
- Page and line reference are included in the left margin of the transcript
- Create single or multi-segment clips with an easy-to-use highlighter
- Edit clips for precise begin and end points using included tools
- Quickly review clip edits using the "Seek to Start" and "Seek to End" controls

- Share edited clips with others via email as either an MPEG-4 (H.246) file or a Clip Creation Script (.CCS) file for import into TrialDirector®
- Supports Retina Display
- Supports all generations of iPad devices
- Access to inData's top-rated technical support team.
